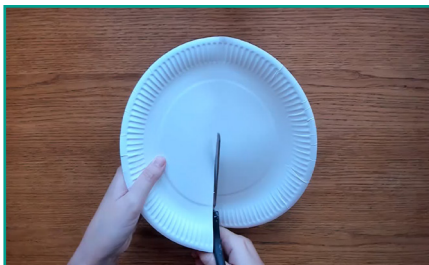


Rocking Paper Plate Snowman



You will need:

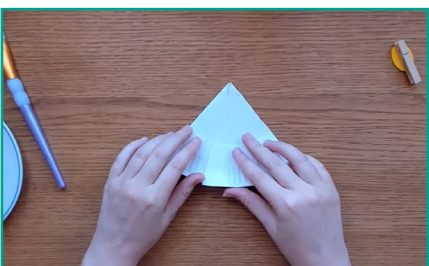
- A paper plate
- Glue and scissors
- Colourful paper
- Ribbon
- A black pen or pencil



1) First, fold your plate in half, pressing the fold so it leaves a line to follow. Now cut along the line you just folded. You will only need half a paper plate for this craft.



2) Bring the two points of the semicircle together to create a cone shape. Now continue so that the two points of the semicircle overlap by about 2cm.



3) Holding the points in place, flatten the cone. Press the new edges you have created so they are crisp.



4) Now unfold the shape and add some glue where they overlap. Leave the glue to dry.

5) Once dried, you can start to decorate your snowman. Use a black pen to add buttons, eyes and a mouth. Cut out pieces of colourful paper or card to create a carrot nose and a top hat.



6) Next, use the ribbon to create a scarf for your snowman. If you do not have ribbon, you could always use more colourful paper.



7) Last of all, stand your rocking snowman up. To make your snowman more stable, put your hands inside the cone and push the sides out slightly so it is less of a flat shape. Give him a little push and watch your snowman rock.
