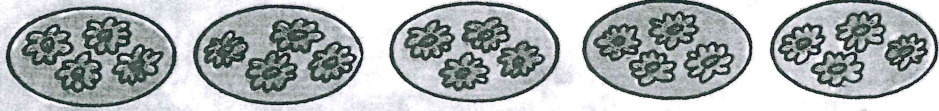


School garden

5 flower beds. 4 flowers in each.

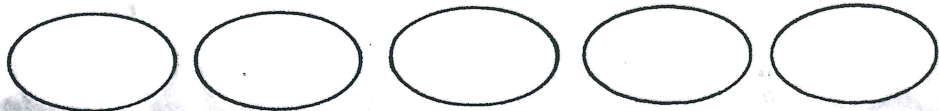


$$5 \times 4 = 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 = 20$$
