



Sticky Drippy Chocolate Slime

Edible Sensory Activity

You will need:

1 tin condensed milk

Cornflour

3 tbsp chocolate sauce/syrup

Large bowl

Wooden spoon

Pan

Method

1. Mix the condensed milk and half a cup of cornflour together.
2. Add the chocolate sauce.
3. Put in the pan and bring to the boil until thickened. Keep stirring.
4. Sprinkle cornflour over the mixture and knead gently for a few minutes.
5. Add more cornflour to reduce the stickiness.
6. Have lots of fun lifting up the slime and letting it ooze down! A super sticky sensory experience!

*Please note that although this recipe is safe for children to taste and explore with their mouths, it is not intended for them to eat in large quantities.
