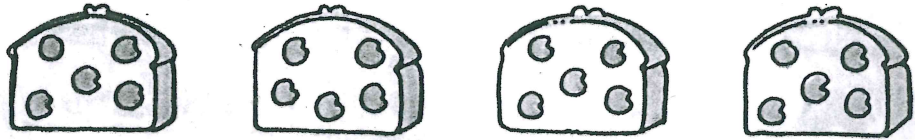


4 slices of cake. 5 cherries in each.
