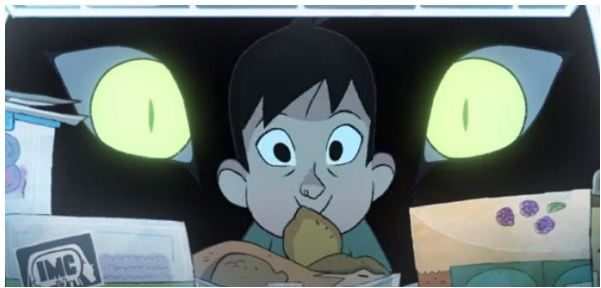

BRONZE ANSWERS - Note - other answers may be acceptable and teachers should use their judgement when assessing

- 1) Night-time. 2) So that he is not heard by anyone else. 3) To have a snack.

- 6) If people eat less meat, humans would not need to farm so many animals. This means less land would be needed so the rainforest would not need to be cut down.
- 7) The jaguar is losing its home. The boy eats some chicken. The rainforest needs to be saved.

SILVER ANSWERS – Note - other answers may be acceptable and teachers should use their judgement when assessing

- 1) Curious to see why the boy is sneaking around as well as wondering what animal the tail belongs to.
- 2) Scary. 3a) Various answers acceptable – these should suggest that the boy is frightened.
- 3b) The boy thinks the animal may be there to ‘feast’ and worried that it might eat him. It is also clear that he is frightened in his reaction to seeing the animal along with how he describes it (eyes, tail, claws). It would also scare the boy seeing the damage the animal has caused.
- 4) The boy is wearing shorts and his family have had a summer barbeque.
- 5) To inform the boy.
- 6) It is being destroyed by humans in order to clear land so that they may farm animals for their meat and milk.
- 7) He vowed to eat less meat, raise awareness and protest the destruction of the rainforest.
- 8a) That it is a violent and frightening animal. 8b) That it is vulnerable and in need of help.
- 9) Various answers acceptable – these may be related to either the destruction of the rainforest or the human impact on the environment.

GOLD ANSWERS – Note - other answers may be acceptable and teachers should use their judgement when assessing

- 1) Night-time. It is dark. The boy is wearing night-time attire. Lights are on in the buildings outside. The boy is moving around quietly suggesting he does not want to wake up anyone else.
- 2) Playing suspenseful music. Showing only the tail of the animal leaving the viewer wondering what it is. Having the boy move around quietly makes the viewer wonder what he is doing.
- 3) The leftovers represent the reason for the destruction of the jaguar’s home. The milk and meat on the floor represents what is being produced from animals that are being farmed on destroyed/cleared rainforest land.
- 4a) At the start the video, the jaguar seems fierce, aggressive and dangerous. At the end of the video, the jaguar can be perceived as vulnerable, frightened and worried.
- 4b) To create sympathy for the creature. The viewer would feel sorry for the animal and take action to help.
- 5) Cutting down and clearing away the jaguar’s habitat in order to create farming space.
- 6) Comfort/consolation/relief.
- 7) He vowed to eat less meat, raise awareness and protest the destruction of the rainforest. This means there will be a lesser need for land to farm animals as there is less demand for animal products. By protesting, this will raise awareness and people would demand an end to the destruction of the rainforest.
- 8) Fearful for the boy as it seems the jaguar is behind him like a predator ready to attack its prey. Also, the boy is unaware that the animal is behind him adding to the feeling of danger.
- 9) It suggests the damage to the rainforest is widespread and across a large area.
- 10) Various answers acceptable – these should demonstrate the jaguar’s fear of the humans.
