



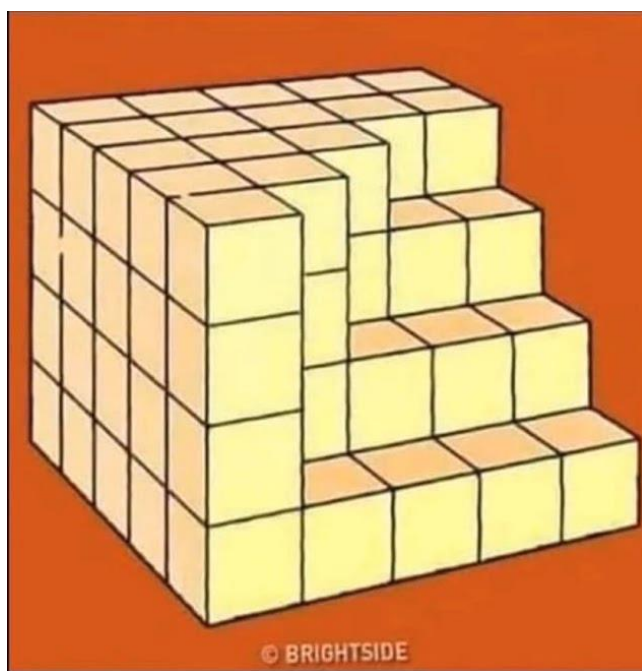
Titanic project
