Email a copy of your letter to your P6 teacher and we will pass all the letters to the P7 teachers.

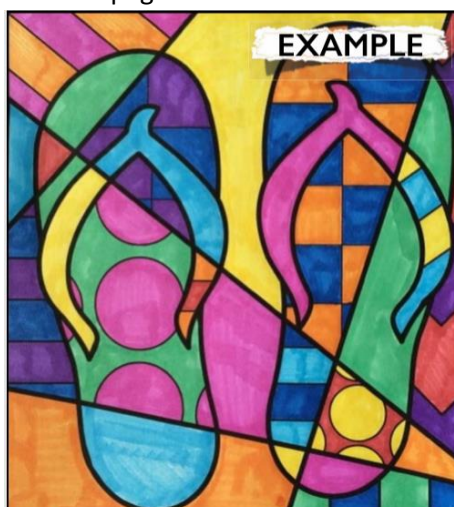
