

Multiplication and division word problems 2nd March 2021



Read each question carefully and decide if you need to **multiply or divide**. Do your working out in the space provided and, once you've finished, do the **inverse calculation** to check your work.

Problem	Working out	Inverse calculation
1. A daily newspaper costs 65p. If I buy a copy each day from Monday to Friday, how much will I have spent?		
2. A bakery sells bread rolls in packs of 4. How many bread rolls will they need to fill 76 packs?		
3. There are six slices of bacon in each pack. If a butcher cuts 102 slices of bacon, how many packs can he make?		
4. 59 pizzas were delivered last night and each one was cut into 8 slices. How many slices of pizza were there altogether?		
5. A large tub of Smarties contains 156 sweets. If they were shared equally between 4 people, how many Smarties would each person receive?		
6. It cost £28.50 for five of us to go to the cinema. If we split the cost equally, how much did each person pay?
