Read each question carefully. There are two steps to each question. How will you work out each step? Do you need to add, subtract, multiply or divide? Do your working out for each step in the space provided.

Problem	Step 1 Working out	Step 2 Working out
1. 25 passengers got onto the bus at the station. At the first stop, 7 passengers got off and then another 13 passengers got on. How many passengers were now on the bus?		
2. I bought four magazines each costing £1.75. I paid with a £10 note. How much change did I receive?		
3. There are 230 pages in my book. I read 15 pages each night. After ten nights, how many pages will I still have left to read?		
4. The P6 teachers were given a box of Miniature Heroes which contained 68 sweets. Mrs Bell ate $\frac{1}{4}$ of them and gave another 20 to Mr Massey. How many sweets were left for Mr Coetzee?		
5. I do football training three nights per week from 18.45 to 19.30. How many minutes per week do I spend at training?		
6. In a theatre, there are 265 seats downstairs and 195 seats upstairs. On Friday evening there were 356 people in the theatre. How many seats were unsold?
