



P6 other activities – Monday 18th – Friday 22nd May

This week, we would love for you to join us online for a P6 Zoom meeting as part of our Titanic topic!

Last week we asked you to do the following activities:

- Research – find out about the passengers and crew members travelling onboard Titanic. Visit <https://www.encyclopedia-titanica.org/titanic-passengers-and-crew/> and look through the records of different passengers and crew members. Choose one person who interests you and find out more about them e.g. where did they come from/age/reason for being onboard? Did they survive? If not, was their body ever discovered?
- Now we want you to become the person you have been researching! Write a short speech as if you are the passenger or crew member and tell us all about yourself, your reason for being onboard and about your fate.

e.g. My name is George Alfred Bennett. I was born in Southampton on 23rd July 1881 and my father worked on many ships during his working life. When I grew up, I worked as a stoker on ships such as Titanic's sister ship the Olympic and then I joined Titanic's engineering crew on 6th April 1912 as a fireman. My wage was £6 per month. When Titanic sank, I went down with the ship and my body was never identified. I was 30 years old when I died.

This week, we hope that you will join us online using Zoom on **Thursday afternoon at 3.30pm** and we will all share our speeches about the passengers or crew members we have been researching. If you didn't have time to do your research last week, you can complete it this week before the meeting!

If you would like to take part, please ask an adult to **email Mr Coetzee** rcoetzee517@c2kni.net by Wednesday and he will email you the link to join our Zoom meeting. Don't forget to include your name and class when sending the email to Mr Coetzee.

Before Thursday, practise using Zoom and learn about its different features (including how to mute!). You can have your speech in front of you and even dress up as your Titanic passenger or crew member if you wish! We hope that lots of you will take part – we really miss seeing you all!

Other activities for this week:
