

Extension task - Money word problems 16th March 2021



Read each question carefully and decide how you will work out the answer. Are you adding, subtracting, multiplying or dividing? Be careful - some questions may have two parts. Don't forget to include the decimal point in your working out and in your answer please.

Problem	Working out
1. Mrs Smart bought four copies of the local newspaper when the P6s from Brooklands were on the front cover. She paid £3.80 altogether. How much would one copy of the newspaper cost?	
2. Mr Coetzee owes Mr Massey £35. He says that he will pay half this week and then pay the rest next week. How much money should Mr Massey receive each week?	
3. Mr McKee paid £75 for gymnastics lessons for Anya and £56.50 for hockey coaching for Zara. How much did he pay altogether?	
4. Miss Lyon bought two bags of dog food at £17.75 each and a chew toy at £3.95. How much did she spend altogether?	
5. For Mother's Day, Mrs Bell spent £22 in Asda. She bought a bouquet of flowers at £9.50, a box of chocolates at £4.75 and a bottle of wine. How much did the bottle of wine cost?	
6. Mr Armstrong needs to buy a new washing machine. The one he wants to buy costs £325.99 but, if he buys it today, he will get £70 off as it is on special offer. How much will the washing machine now cost?
