

Extension task - Money word problems 15th March 2021



Read each question carefully and decide how you will work out the answer. Are you adding, subtracting or multiplying? No division today! Be careful - some questions may have two parts. Don't forget to include the decimal point in your working out and in your answer please.

Problem	Working out
1. Mrs Ogborn loves doing art and craft activities but she has run out of ribbon. One metre of ribbon costs £2.95. How much will it cost Mrs Ogborn to buy 8 metres of ribbon?	
2. Mr Armstrong spent £12.75 on Easter eggs and paid with a £20 note. How much change did he receive?	
3. In the fruit shop, Mrs Bell bought a bunch of bananas at £1.36 and she also bought a punnet of raspberries. She paid £4.25 altogether. What price was the punnet of raspberries?	
4. In the newsagents Mrs McKnight chose two magazines at £2.99 each and a comic at £1.25. How much did she pay altogether?	
5. Mr Coetzee needs to buy three large Easter eggs which usually cost £4.99 each but today they are on special offer at three large eggs for £12.50. How much will he save if he buys them with this special offer?	
6. Mr Massey spent £15.70 on flowers and £32.50 on perfume for Mrs Massey's birthday. How much more expensive was the perfume than the flowers?
