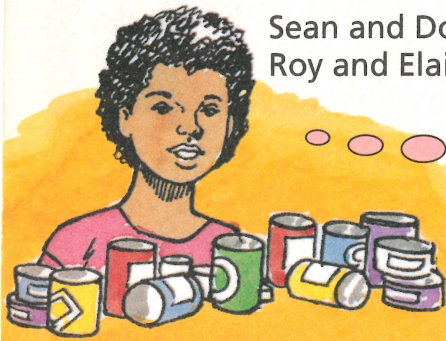


Washed ashore

$$\begin{array}{l} 34 \text{ add } 28 \\ 34 + 20 = 54 \\ 54 + 8 = 62 \end{array}$$

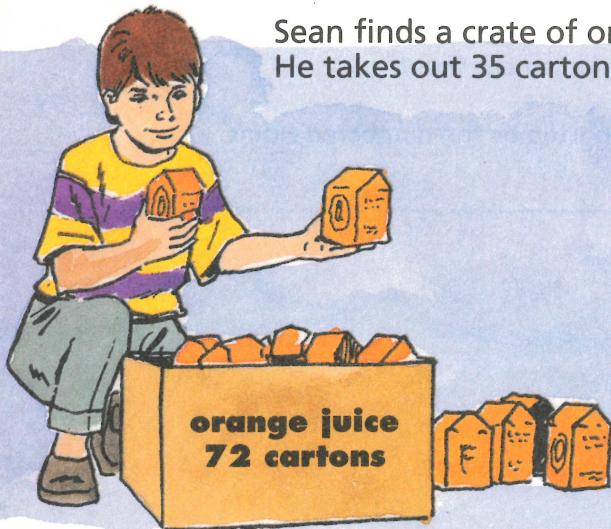
Altogether we found

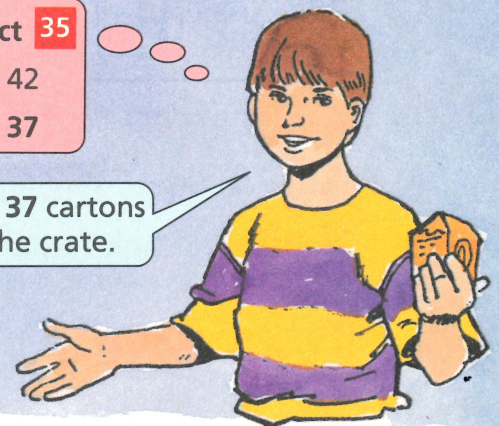
