

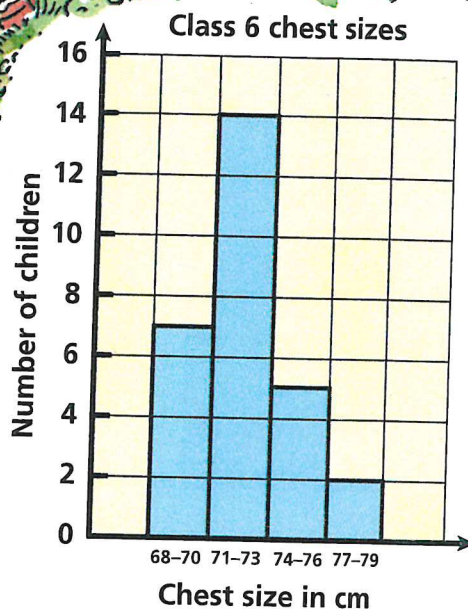

In the graph, the chest sizes are grouped in **class intervals**. The class interval 68–70 includes sizes 68 cm, 69 cm and 70 cm.



- How many class intervals are there in the graph?
  - In which class interval is
    - the largest chest size
    - the smallest chest size?
  - How many children need overalls in these sizes:
    - 68–70 cm
    - 71–73 cm
    - 74–76 cm
    - 77–79 cm?
  - How many children have a chest size
    - smaller than 71 cm
    - larger than 73 cm?
